



XT10 Stand-On Aerator Quick Tip

XT10 Daily Preventative Maintenance Checklist

This is just a general guide, always refer to your manual for detailed instructions

- Daily Cleaning**
 - o Clear the tines, chains, and operators' platform of any dirt or debris. Avoid using high pressure wash
- Engine Oil & Hydraulic Oil - Check Daily**
 - o Engine – 10W-30
 - o Hydraulic Reservoir – 20W-50 Motor Oil
- Inspect Air Cleaner Assembly for Excess Buildup**
 - o TURFCO Part #670612
- Check Tire Pressure**
 - o Rear 28 PSI
- Inspect Hardware**
 - o Inspect tines, tensioners, handles, & depth control hardware for tension. Tighten as necessary
- Inspect Chains**
 - o Inspect chains for lubrication. Apply a light coating of dry chain lube as necessary
 - o Check length of chain for tension. There should be 1/2"-3/4" deflection. Adjust Idler sprocket if needed (**Figure 2**)
- Inspect Belt**
 - o inspect for any uneven wear, damage, debris & tension.
 - o If tension is needed remove V-belt cover and turn adjuster screw to compress spring to a measure of 2-1/2" – 2-5/8" (**Figure 3**)

Tools Used

- Floor Jack or Lift
- Tape Measure
- 9/16" Wrench x 2 (Chain Idler adjustment, Belt Tension & Cover)
- 1/2" Wrench x2 (Tine Hardware)
- 7/16" Wrench x2 (Belt Cover)
- Tire Pressure Gauge

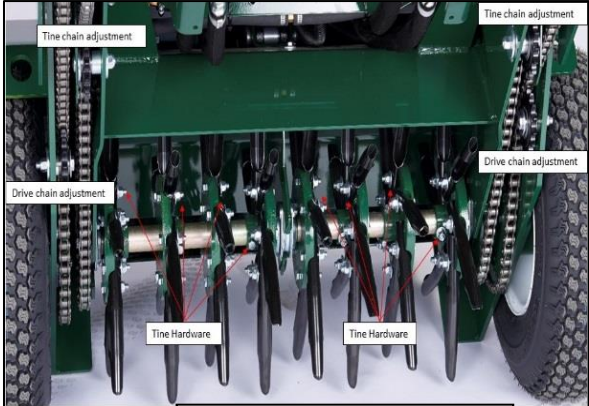


Figure 1: Tine & Chain Assembly

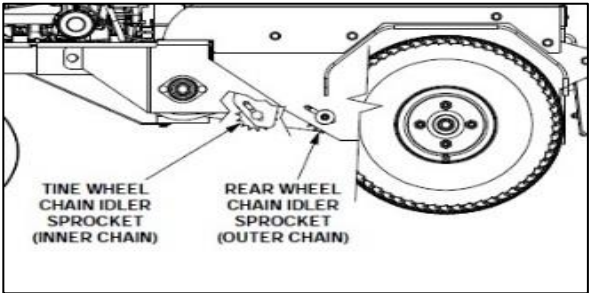


Figure 2: Chain Idler Sprockets

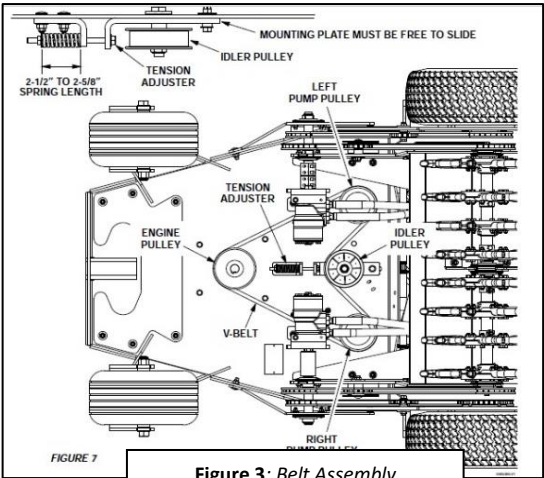


Figure 3: Belt Assembly
